Discussed about the next steps from Dublin meeting. STSM's to work with literature search.

Stephan can host student from Romania.

Ole can host in Denmark. Janne have STSM ideas next period.

Diana had ITC grant in Vienna about zoonosis.

Ole had 2 years project to promote safety culture in farming including website for farmers. Alain have 2 PHD's for agriculture pesticide exposure, machinery risk prevention.

Natasa have PHD student in risk assessment project, perspectives from neighbor countries, collaboration with Jovanka. They have rural health congress coming.

John has his own PHD project fund applied for this research area.

Jarkko told about literature search results so far. Web of Science database was found 131 articles, which 45 chosen for thematic analysis.

Stephan asked that we could collect all information what we already have together. Share what we already have.

Skype online meeting > learning each other and using dropbox? – create a mailing list. Microsoft tool to share documents can be used. We could list and collect everybody expertise and projects, collect the papers which already done. Natasa can make inquiry to do expertise register (WG2).

- One review idea (Jarkko)> definitions and characteristics of safety culture in agriculture > thematic analysis.
- Julie > power structures – one viewpoint
- Small family farms >< large business farms,
- Worker >< employer viewpoints etc..
- Alain > point of view in safety, non-expert >< expert comparison...

- Following rules in industry, in farming it is different , formal >< informal, bad communication, discussion of safety culture differences > among other safety culture

- 2. Safety culture differences on farms,

- 3. (Intermediate products), attitude, barriers of safety, group of determinants

- 4. Bojan > agriculture machinery > tractor drivers safety behavior, risks for the drivers > > expert of group > what is important when developing safety culture > differences, models.

> Jarkko have had agriculture machinery safety project in Finland, which have done report in Finnish. Two presentations have been in English.

Participatory observation can be one method.

Questionnaire survey next step:> survey questionnaire

Data collection > survey on protocols, behavior,

> measurement tool for example KSL

> what are available tools improve safety> or measure safety culture
