agricultural policies. Update the CAP policy objectives to include workplace risk management using ‘Safety Culture’, ‘Zero Vision’ and ‘One Health’ principles.

- Establish a European Network for Agricultural Safety and Health with regional and state affiliated organizations focusing on the safety, health, well-being and sustainability of people involved in agriculture.
- Allocate specific funding for agricultural safety, health and well-being research in Horizon 2020 / Horizon Europe.
- Develop and implement a safety, health and well-being risk assessment, education & skills program for primary producers, including self-employed farmers, family members, workers and students in agricultural schools.
- Improve Eurostat and national statistics to reflect the true incidence and severity of agricultural workplace death, injury and ill-health.
- If there are money left on budget; WG5 suggest a follow up meeting with in Brussels in May/April 2020.
